New Tulsi Avenue Park Opens

Located across the road from Riverwalk Primary School, the recently opened Tulsi Avenue Park is the third park we have delivered at Riverwalk, along with Liberator Park and the popular Village Park.

Just over one hectare in size, the architecturally-designed park features a picnic shelter, a selection of playground equipment, a dedicated nature-play area and several recreation spaces including a basketball half-court.

Stage 1 Acoustic Wall complete

The first stage of the acoustic wall has been installed along the southern boundary of Riverwalk (bordering the Princes Freeway). This wall reduces traffic noise for residents, making Riverwalk an even more peaceful place to live.

We were able to retain all trees bordering the freeway, providing important amenity and an additional barrier between the homes and traffic.

The second stage of the wall will commence in 2024.

Mixed Use Site Update

We are pleased to announce that Arcare (a subsidiary of Knowles Group) has purchased the mixed-use site at Riverwalk with the intention to build a high-quality residential aged care facility.

We are currently working closely with Arcare to finalise a development proposal for the site to be submitted to Wyndham Council for approval.

Further information on the proposed development and timeline for delivery will be provided in future updates.

Town Centre Update

Orena Group, who purchased the Town Centre site in June 2022, have finalised their planning application and submitted to Wyndham Council for approval.

The Town Centre is anticipated to include a supermarket, along with a range of other speciality retail shops and services.

Further information on timing and proposed services will be shared with the community once the planning application has been approved.

Progress Updates

Southern Wetland: We have recently completed civil construction of the Southern Wetland and are now moving onto landscaping. Once complete, the new wetland will provide a habitat for local animals and plants as well as providing storage and treatment of stormwater.

Farm Road signalised intersection:

Traffic lights are now in operation at the intersection of Princes Highway and Farm Road, allowing for the safer flow of local traffic and pedestrian movement in and out of the estate. Residents are also enjoying an improved, safer road surface following an upgrade to a section of Farm Road. Stages 29 – 36: Civil construction is continuing across Stages 34-36, with asphalting works now underway on Stage 34, electrical works underway on Stage 35 and road boxing taking place on Stage 36.

Settlements for Stages 29, 31, 32 and 33 took place recently and settlements for Stages 34 and 35 are scheduled to occur in the coming months, with Stage 36 to follow in early-2024.

Stage 41: We are currently releasing land within stage 41, with remaining lots selling fast. There will be more opportunities to purchase in this stage soon – learn more at myriverwalk.com.au.
