Edgars Road

No doubt you've seen the progress made since our last update, on the construction of Edgars Road between the newly widened O'Herns Road and Rockfield Street.

Our contractor is progressing well with the works, and while ongoing rainfall has slowed this process, we expect the final section of Edgars Road to be completed by late 2022.

This road will deliver benefits to the community including better access to local facilities and connection to the Hume Freeway Interchange.

Please be aware that while construction continues there may be some noise and additional traffic, and nearby homes may also notice increased levels of dust.
