

# Melbourne Arts Precinct Transformation

## Construction update April 2023

The demolition of the Harold Alexander Terrace at the back of Arts Centre Melbourne is almost complete.

There will be no workers on site from Friday 7 April to Wednesday 12 April. There will also be no construction on Monday 24 and Tuesday 25 April.

Following the closure of Sturt Street between the southern side of Kavanagh Street and Southbank Boulevard, a construction site is being established to temporarily move utilities to the back of the NGV Garden. Starting this month, we will be relocating services behind the hoarding.

Plane trees have been removed along Sturt Street behind the hoarding. This is part of the services relocation works.

A reminder that Arts Centre Melbourne, NGV International and The Primrose Potter Australian Ballet Centre will remain open throughout the works.

The Primrose Potter Australian Ballet Centre and Arts Centre Melbourne car parks will also remain open throughout construction.

## New interim Ballet Bridge

The pedestrian footbridge connecting Arts Centre Melbourne's Theatres Building (under the Spire) to Level 4 of The Primrose Potter Australian Ballet Centre was taken down during March.

There is currently no pedestrian access between Arts Centre Melbourne Forecourt and level 4 of The Primrose Potter Australian Ballet Centre.

Keep your eyes peeled for the new interim bridge which will be installed in the coming months!

## National Gallery of Victoria International

To ensure the ongoing operations of National Gallery of Victoria International (NGV International) during the construction of The Fox: NGV Contemporary, we are undertaking some internal work in NGV International.

Preparatory works at NGV International will begin this month. At this stage, there will be no external disruptions, however an update will be provided if this changes.

## Works on utilities

Services such as power, water, sewerage and communications need to be re-routed or relocated by the relevant authorities to get ready for major works on the project.

In April, Multinet Gas will be working in Kavanagh Street to replace a gas main. Affected residents will be contacted directly by Multinet Gas.
