

THE FOX: NGV CONTEMPORARY

Cranes will continue to be installed on the site of The Fox: NGV Contemporary.

The installation of the pedestrian gantry continues along Southbank Boulevard. There will be another gantry installed along the Kavanagh Street side of the site later in April. This may result in lane closures during the works. Local residents and traders will be notified when dates have been confirmed.

What to expect

- Footpath and cyclist lane diversions in place.
- Traffic management in place as required.
- There will be out of hours works Friday 10 April – Sunday 12 April between 8am and 6pm.

HOARDING MOVEMENTS

From April 13, there will be changes to the hoarding between Arts Centre Melbourne Theatres Building and NGV International. The current walkway will change from along the NGV International Building to along the Theatres Building as highlighted below in green.

Works for Laak Boorndap, the new garden are progressing. Next to Hamer Hall, a gantry has been installed above the walkway for pedestrian and cyclist safety. The gantry install will cover a few sections of the handrails in the walkway. For those with accessibility requirements, the map below provides an alternate route.
