



Development Victoria is transforming the former VicRoads site in Kew into a vibrant new neighbourhood, providing hundreds of homes for a range of households and budgets. Work is now set to begin on this multi-year redevelopment.

Site preparation works

From mid-August, you will see increased activity on site as fencing is put up in preparation for early works, which include stripping out the inside of the buildings and putting up scaffolding.

We're committed to managing these activities with care and minimising impact on the surrounding area.

We'll provide more details about this work as it progresses throughout the year.

Developer engagement

The process of identifying private sector developers for the project is progressing, with a select group of developers now preparing proposals.

By partnering with the private sector, we aim to build homes faster and provide a range of housing options.

We expect to have a private sector partner in place by early - mid 2026 and will let you know once this is confirmed.

Community engagement

Earlier this year, we invited Kew residents to share their ideas and aspirations for the site through an online survey and two community information events.

We would like to thank everyone who provided their ideas for the site and came to these events to ask questions.

A summary of the findings will soon be published on the Development Victoria and Engage Victoria websites.
