## Work is progressing on the Victorian Government's Revitalising Central Dandenong (RCD) project

The Victorian Government is transforming Dandenong into a vibrant retail, commercial and residential hub and creating thousands of jobs, and will partner with the private sector to deliver the next stage of the Revitalising Central Dandenong project.

Melbourne-based developer Capital Alliance will invest \$600 million to develop five key sites in central Dandenong and has developed a draft master plan to share with community and stakeholders.

The draft master plan showcases Capital Alliance's plans for Dandenong, including at least 470 new dwellings, community spaces, a hotel and conference centre, an urban brewery entertainment district, an education facility, retail, medical, a cinema and a new Little India Precinct.

Construction is expected to start in 2023 and the first stage will include a supermarket, food market hall and residential development alongside the new Little India Precinct.

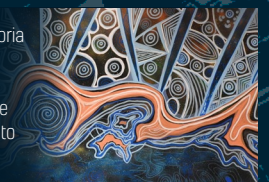
