

## 77 SOUTHBANK BOULEVARD

The final stage of deconstruction is ongoing, with the removal of the basement structure.

The works will continue to move progressively around the site throughout October.

### What to expect:

- Mid-level hammering and intermittent noise from movement of large loads.
- Truck movement mainly via Southbank Boulevard, some movements required via Kavanagh Street.
- Works will be taking place until December 2024.
- Southbank Boulevard footpath will reopen in the first half of October.

## ARTS CENTRE MELBOURNE & KAVANAGH/STURT STREET INTERSECTION

Excavation is currently underway behind Arts Centre Melbourne and you can start to see where the boundary of the building will be.

Preparations for additional work under the deck structure in the intersection will occur throughout October.

### What to expect:

- Arts Centre Melbourne car park remains open.
- Traffic managers will be on site during construction hours to assist

with keeping the car park and loading docks operating.

## BLUESTONE REINSTATEMENT

There are additional bluestone reinstatement works taking place on the corner of Sturt Street and Southbank Boulevard.

### What to expect:

- Limited pedestrian access along the northern side of Southbank Boulevard, outside NGV International.
- Directional signage to guide pedestrians.

## AUTHORITIES – HARRIS CIVIL SEWER WORKS

Authority works are continuing to take place around the precinct. These works are staged to minimise disruption.

Works are scheduled to commence in Fanning Street, Southbank on 14 October.

### What to expect:

- Road closure on Fanning Street between Kavanagh and Fawkner Street.
- Pedestrian access on footpath maintained.
- Low construction noise.
- Traffic management to guide vehicles.

Local residents and businesses who may be impacted by any works will be notified accordingly.
