

77 SOUTHBANK BOULEVARD

To make way for the new The Fox: NGV Contemporary, we are in the process of deconstructing the former CUB building at 77 Southbank Boulevard.

The final stage of deconstruction is the removal of the basement structure, which requires a change in methodology.

What to expect:

- Mid-level hammering.
- 3 large and 2-3 smaller machines, including compactors and rollers.
- Truck movement mainly via Southbank Boulevard, some movements required via Kavanagh Street.
- Works will be taking place until December 2024.

AUTHORITIES – HARRIS CIVIL SEWER WORKS

BLUESTONE REINSTATEMENT

The reinstatement of bluestone pavement along Fanning Street will be taking place Tuesday 3 September until Tuesday 17 September.

What to expect:

- Works 7am-5pm Monday-Friday, with the exception of Monday 16 September.
- Access into businesses will be maintained throughout works.
- Traffic management will be in place to assist with pedestrian movement.

BLUESTONE REINSTATEMENT

There are additional bluestone reinstatement works taking place on Southbank Boulevard until mid-September.

What to expect:

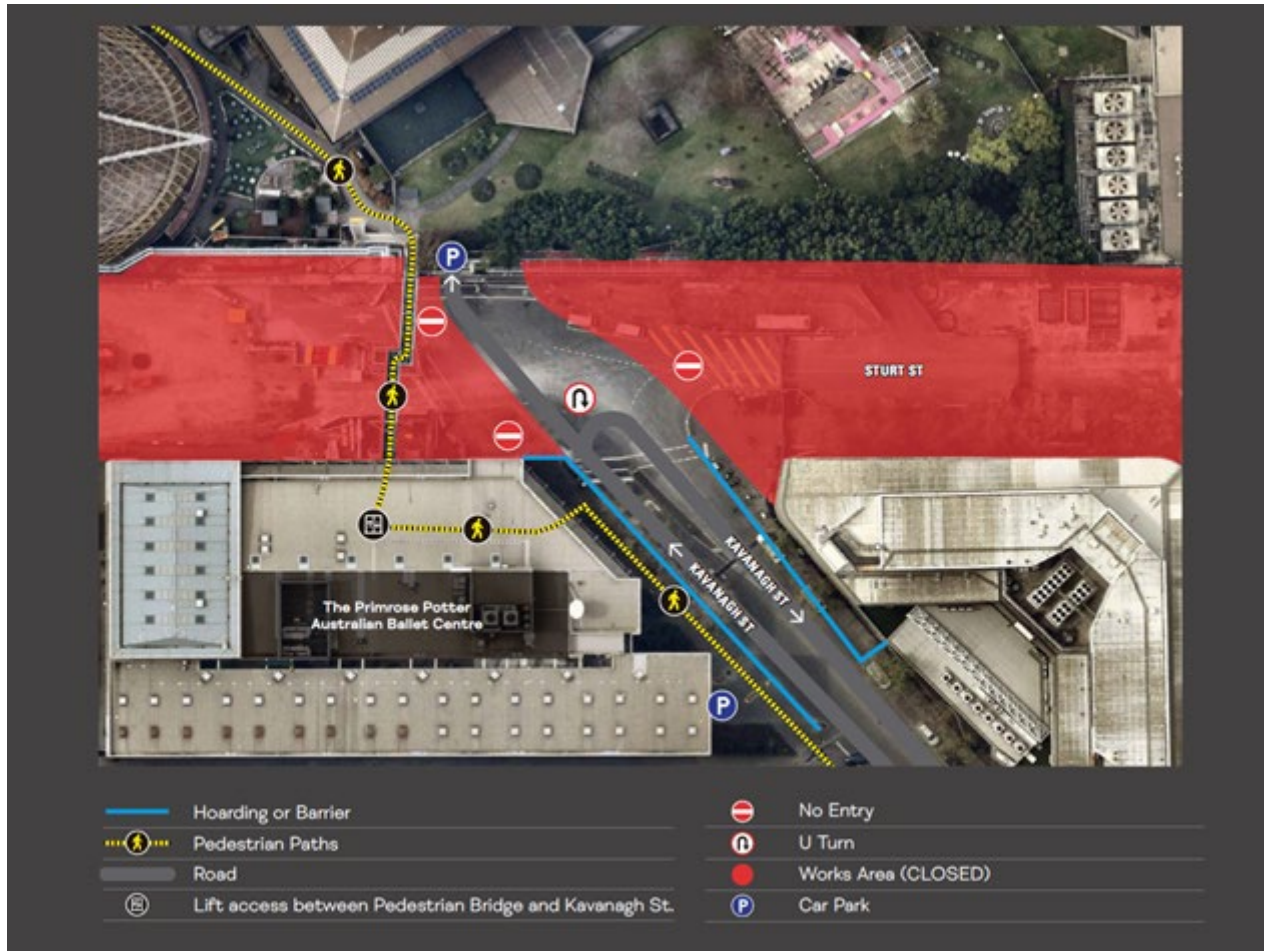
- Limited pedestrian access along the northern side of Southbank Boulevard, outside NGV International.
