

77 SOUTHBANK BOULEVARD

Site crews are mobilising for works to commence in mid-March on The Fox: NGV Contemporary. Plant and equipment deliveries to the site have commenced and will continue into April.

What to expect:

- Intermittent footpath closures along the south side of Kavanagh Street for minor hoarding and gate adjustments.
- Increased activity around the site, within approved traffic plans.

AUTHORITIES – HARRIS CIVIL SEWER WORKS

Harris Civil are completing sewer works in Fanning Street in March. Following this, unused sewers and manholes around the precinct will be decommissioned. These works are staged to minimise disruption.

What to expect:

- Road closures on Fanning Street at the Fawkner Street intersection.
- Access to the Mantra Hotel and Holiday Inn Express carpark is retained.
- Pedestrian access on footpath maintained.
- Low construction noise.
- Traffic management to guide vehicles.

Local residents and businesses who may be impacted by any works will be notified accordingly.

PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE ADJUSTMENT

An adjustment will be made to the temporary pedestrian bridge on the Level 4 of the Primrose Potter Australian Ballet Centre side.

What to expect:

- The bridge will be closed for a short period of time to facilitate the transition in mid-March.
- Closure is planned to occur during hours that will be of minimal impact.

Alternative pedestrian routes to St Kilda Road include along Southbank Boulevard or down Fanning Street, across City Road and via the path from Southgate Avenue, next to Hamer Hall.

BEHIND ARTS CENTRE MELBOURNE

From 24 March 2025 to early May, access into the Arts Centre Melbourne car park will be via Southbank Boulevard only. The Arts Centre Melbourne car park entrance in Kavanagh Street will be closed temporarily to allow for work on the Laak Boorndap deck super structure.

Basement excavation and structure construction continues behind Arts Centre Melbourne's Theatres Building.

What to expect:

- Arts Centre Melbourne car park remains open with access from Southbank Boulevard only.
