

## AUTHORITIES – HARRIS CIVIL SEWER WORKS

Authority works are continuing to take place around the precinct. These works are staged to minimise disruption.

### What to expect:

- Road closures on Fanning Street between Kavanagh Street and City Road.
- Pedestrian access on footpath maintained.
- Low construction noise.
- Traffic management to guide vehicles.

## 77 SOUTHBANK BOULEVARD

The deconstruction is now complete, and the piling mat fill is installed. Hoarding is being installed around the site in November.

### What to expect:

- Footpath adjacent to Kavanagh Street side continues to be closed.
- Truck movement mainly via Southbank Boulevard, some movements required via Kavanagh Street.
- Dust suppression.

## PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE REDIRECTION

The temporary pedestrian bridge between St Kilda Road and the Level 4 of the Primrose Potter Australian Ballet Centre will be redirected to allow for the deck superstructure works to continue.

### What to expect:

- The bridge will be closed for short periods of time to facilitate the transition of the existing bridge to the new one.
- Closures will occur during hours that will be of minimal impact to users.

Alternative pedestrian routes to St Kilda Road include along Southbank Boulevard or down Fanning Street, across City Road and via the path from Southgate Avenue next to Hamer Hall.

## ARTS CENTRE MELBOURNE & KAVANAGH/STURT STREET INTERSECTION

Excavation continues behind Arts Centre Melbourne and you can start to see where the boundary of the building will be.

Stub and bracing installation to the Kavanagh St intersection superstructure is underway.

### What to expect:

- Arts Centre Melbourne car park remains open.
- Traffic managers will be on site during construction hours to assist with keeping the car park and loading docks operating.
