

## TEMPORARY PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE ADJUSTMENTS

There will be a slight adjustment to the temporary pedestrian bridge entrance from the Level 4 of the Primrose Potter Australian Ballet Centre in early May.

### What to expect:

- Temporary pedestrian bridge remains open throughout works.
- Minor disruptions are anticipated as hoarding, handrails and scaffold bays are readjusted in front of the Level 4 Ballet entrance.

## TREE REMOVAL

City of Melbourne will be removing trees around the 77 Southbank Boulevard site including on Southbank Boulevard and Kavanagh Street. This will enable works to continue for The Fox: NGV Contemporary.

Tree removal will occur Tuesday 6 May to Friday 9 May.

### What to expect:

- Intermittent footpath closures along Southbank Boulevard and Kavanagh Street for pedestrian safety.
- Traffic managers will be on site during tree removal times.
- Low construction noise.

## HOARDING MOVEMENTS

The hoarding next to the Barre will be adjusted in early May to allow for future works.

There will be no impact to patrons and pedestrians.
